## THE CONCEPT

Residences as a pretext to **meet**, an **artistic project** bringing together citizens who are in marginalized situations or not around the co-creation of an artwork.


An artistic twinning – mediator of Exeko at the crossroads of **cultural mediation** (having access to the artistic practice) and to **intellectual mediation** (being able to wonder about the purpose of art).

An accessibility lever to the artistic practice for all.

## How does it work?

During about ten workshops in the street, parks, and/or in the network of our community partners, participants, under the direction of an artist accompanied by a mediator, co-create a work which, once completed, will be presented in the public space.

The goal is not the result nor the quality of the work but the process of creation, the social mix (being physically together and collaborating in a common work), the encounters and the experience as much in between the artist and the co-creators than for itself.


